

eBook Access via **WebAssign**. ONLINE HOMEWORK AND GRADING

If your previous Math 141/142 instructor required you to use WebAssign, you may have purchased eBook access to *Calculus – Early Transcendentals (ET)*, 2nd edition, by Rogawski, W.H. Freeman Publishing Company.

To regain access to your eBook this semester, follow the steps below:

- Go to webassign.net and click on the “[Forgot your username?](#)” link.
- You will be asked to enter your email address. Your WebAssign account may be associated with your UT email address in this form: UTNetID@tennessee.edu, if your instructor linked WebAssign through Blackboard, or you may have created your own account with another email address.
- Check your email to get your username and institution code.
- Use the Reset Password link at the bottom of the email to reset your password so that you will be able to log in to WebAssign via webassign.net.
- Once logged in, you should see My eBooks listed at the top of the screen. Click to access your eBook.


